This term our theme is MEDIA MAYHEM. This week in year 2 we have lots of exciting lessons planned...

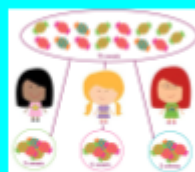
Phonics:

We will be continuing our Read Write Inc phonics scheme where children will build their phonological knowledge and apply their writing skills to different genres of writing each week in our groups!



Maths:

As mathematicians, we'll be exploring division and using our MNP books to gain a deeper understanding of what division means.



History:

As Historians, we will be coming to the end of our topic and will be answering our big question of How do we remember the Great Fire of London? We will draw upon previous learning to help us.



Grammar:

This week we will be exploring verbs again but looking at how they vary depending on the tense. Do we need a past or present tense verb?
