This weeks learning..

In English this week the children will begin planning, creating and publishing a polished piece of writing about workhouses. The children will research information using chromebooks to inform their finished non chronological reports.

We are continuing our Maths - No Problem! scheme and this week the children will be completing multiplication and will begin learning about division.

As scientists we will investigate the pattern between volume and the strength of vibration of a sound source. We will be using decibel meters to compare the amplitude of soundwaves with the volume of a sound source. As historians we will be using organisational and communication skills to explore how transport changed during the Industrial Revolution. We will be discussing roads, canals, railways and the effect they had.

In R.E. the children will identify how the Bible inspired people and what people, guidance and sayings have inspired us.

The children have been very busy in music learning the songs for our Christmas Concert on Thursday 15th December, they sound great!

The songs and music are on Google Classroom for the children to practise at home.

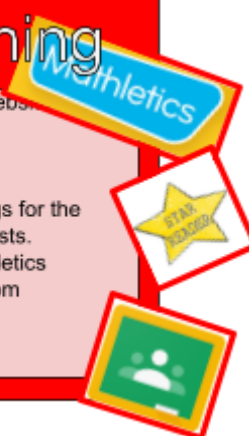
Over to you...Home learning
