Happy New Year! We knope you've enjoyed a wonderful time with family and friends over the holiday season. This time of year is a great opportunity to set personal goals? Maybe you could set yourself a new year's resolution and try something new this year!

We are starting a new topic this term; The Earth our Home! This will be a really exciting opportunity to learn all about the world around us. We have super fun things planned and we can't wait to get started!

Enalish:

As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

Our focus books this term will be, Where's the Elephant and A to Z of Endangered Animals.
