## his weeks learning

This half term our topic is going to be focused on Earth our home.

In English We will be looking at persuasive letter writing. We will be planning and writing our own letters about saving the planet!

In Maths we will be looking at measuring length. We are starting off by comparing centimetres and metres and will move on to exploring millimetres later in the week.
