# Year 1 Newsletter

## Our Learning

Thank you everyone for coming to our postponed Christmas performance last week! It was wonderful to see all the children's hard work pay off.

#### English:

As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

Our focus books this term will be, Where's the Elephant and A to Z of Endangered Animals.

#### Maths:

As mathematicians, we've been looking at measuring height and length. What could you measure at home? This week we'll be reviewing and assessing our number work with 1 – 20. Make sure to log into Mathletics to get lots of practise.

#### Science-

As scientists, we will continue to look at **Animals including humans**. We will be thinking carefully about what different animals eat and learning the names, **Carnivore**, **Herbivore** and **Omnivore**. What animals can you think of?

Geography: As geographers, we will be looking at our local area through maps and exploring our routes to school. How do you get to school?

Art: As artists, we will focus on collage and print this term. We will create Matisse inspired prints this week using paints and sponges..

<u>Computing:</u> Using technology we will be creating a digital campaign to help protect endangered animals using the app, Sketches Schools on the iPads.
