Our Learning

English:

As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

Our focus books this term will be, Where's the Elephant and A to Z of Endangered Animals.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we are going to be learning about numbers to 40. Can you count to 40? Science:

As scientists, we will continue to look at **Animals including humans**. We will be thinking carefully about how we could help endangered animals from climate change. We will be designing a poster to raise awareness and help planet Earth – our home.

Make sure your child comes to school every day!


- Read everyday for 10 minutes. We will be giving out three reading books; an Oxford book, a
