This half term our topic is going to be focused on Earth our home.

In English We have completed publishing our persuasive letters to the Prime Minister in which we present our suggestions about how we can safe our planet. We will be starting Cycle 2 in which we explore Leaflets as part of persuasive writing.

In Maths we will be moving on to look at mass. In this topic, we will be learning how to weigh a range of items, accurately read scales and convert between grams and kilograms confidently.

In Science: We will be taking a closer look at where our food comes from on plants. It could be the leaves, the roots or a fruit that grows on the plant! We will then take a look at the seeds we have planted to check on their growth.
