This week's learning...







Shared Reading: We will be using our retrieval and inference skills to read a variety of texts focusing on echo reading; deepening our understanding of ambitious vocabulary and giving our opinions using evidence from the texts.

English: We will be listening to different podcasts on environmental topics and identify their key features. We will then conduct interviews which we will write about in a newspaper article.

Maths: We will be continuing our work on decimals by learning how to divide decimals and will move on to finding percentages.

Science: We will be exploring the characteristics of different plants and identifying how they are classified and will be drawing scientific diagrams of plants.

Geography: We will be debating the argument for and against whether the land surrounding volcanoes is a suitable place to live.

RE: We will be exploring a range of beliefs that different religions and world views use to answer the question 'What is the purpose of life?'

Art: Our artist study this week will be on Barbara Kruger and her thought provoking slogans. We will use her ideas to create our own slogans based on climate change.
