Just like that, we are in the last week of this half term! Children's Mental Health Week 2023 is taking place this week and we aim to raise awareness of this with the children.



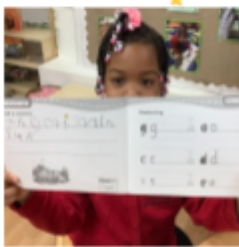
During phonics, we will review and assess the sounds that children have learnt. While in maths, we will be deepening our understanding of numbers up to 10.
