## English:

As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday. Our focus books this term will be , Where's the Elephant and A to Z of Endangered Animals.

## Maths:

As mathematicians, we will be adding and subtracting numbers up to 20. A way to practise this at home is to log in to Mathletics.

## Science:

As scientists, we will be making observations on the changing seasons. We will think about the changes between Autumn and Winter, can you notice any signs of winter with your child while you're out and about?
