### This weeks learning

This half term our topic is going to be focused on Earth our home.

In English We will be publishing (which means editing and improving!) our persuasive leaflets this week - all about deforestation. We will then be planning and performing our debate. Our debate is about farming for deforestation.

In Maths we will be moving on to look at volume and capacity. In this topic, we will be learning how to compare the volume and capacity of a range of liquids and accurately convert between units of liquids.
