This term our theme is Express Yourself. This week in year 2 we have lots of exciting lessons planned.

Phonics/English:

We will be confinuing our Read Write inc phonics scheme where children will build their phonological knowledge and apply their writing skills to different genres of writing each week in our groups. Some groups will be continuing with the Writing Cycle where they will be focusing on storytelling based on the amazing book - Door.



Maths:

As mathematicians we will be focusing on solving word problems, Using our number knowledge we will be applying this to challenging questions to find the answer.

RE:

This term in RE we will be thinking about 'Why is Easter important to Christians?' We will delive into the Easter story and key components and lessons behind it.



Geography:
