OUT Learning Our school theme this term: Express yourself Express yourself

This week we celebrate World Book Day on the 2nd March. So the whole week will be packed full of exciting reading activities. We invite your child to dress up a character from their favourite book on that day. Who will you become? We can't wait to see all of your costumes. If your child has a favourite book they would like to sha with the class they are welcomed to bring it in.

English:

As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday

Please remember to practise your mock phonics screening check tests and watch Ruth Miskin videos everyday.

Maths No Problem:

As mathematicians, we will continue to explore multiplication. We will be thinking about how doubling is creating an identical number to the one you started with, We will also be applying our knowledge of multiplication to solve word problems.

Science:

As scientists, we will be thinking about the main structure of a plant. We will be planting our very own bean plants and keeping a diary over the coming weeks to record their growth.

Geography: As geographers, we will be looking at Russia and thinking about how we could travel there. We will be using a variety of resources including atlases, globes, Google Earth and Digimap.

Art: As artists, we will be exploring Expressionism and the artist Wassily Kandinsky. We will be using watercolours to paint circles and shapes in our sketchbooks.

Religious Education: As theologians, we will be thinking about how Christians show they belong. We will be looking at examples of things some people wear to show they belong to a religion.

RSHE: our school topic is achievement and happiness. They will look back at timelines created last week and predict what goals they would like to achieve in the future.
