Our Learning

Our school theme this term: Express yourself

Enalish:

As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

Please remember to practise your mock phonics screening check tests and watch Ruth Miskin videos everyday.

Maths No Problem:

As mathematicians, we will begin to explore division. We will be thinking about how to share numbers out equally. We will use our multiplication knowledge to help us make sure we have the same numbers in each group. We will also be applying our knowledge of division to solve word problems.

Science:

As scientists, we will continue to monitor the growth of our very own Dahlia seeds! We will learning about other British wildflowers and comparing the features of them to a Dahlia. Can you spot any flowers in the area you live?

Computing:

We will be exploring programming and algorithms through Beebots. We will think about the best algorithm we could input to move them around our maps we made last week!

Geography: As geographers, we will be comparing the features of a Russian city with Canning Town. We will be researching how a city looks different in another part of the world...

Art: As artists, we will continue using watercolours to explore and create primary and secondary colours in our sketchbooks.
