Phonics/English:

We will be confinuing our Read Write Inc phonics scheme where children will build their phonological knowledge and apply their writing skills to different genres of writing each week in our groups. Some groups will be continuing with the Writing Cycle where they will be focusing on storytelling based on the amazing book - Door.



As mathematicians we will be continuing to learn about money. We will explore different coins and money notes. We will use our adding and subtraction to explore total amounts and change.
