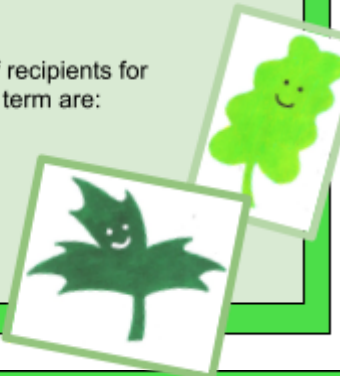
WORLD BOOK DAY -

This week's online learning:

This week as musicians the children will continue with our Festival of Voices journey. The next rehearsal will be here at Star but keep a lookout for our parentmail letting you know when we will be practising at other local schools.

As we continue our new topic, Express Yourself, we have lots of new learning to look forward to. As writers the children will be creating their own African story. They will plan their characters, setting, the dilemma and the resolution over the course of the week. As mathematicians we will continue our work on fractions. As we continue to prepare for the Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) please continue to support your child with practising these at home www.timestables.co.uk has a great platform for practising these within the 5 second time limit.

We will continue with our learning about Africa in geography and in particular looking at the similarities and differences between Kenya and the U.K. As scientists the children will look at constructing simple circuits, naming components and drawing scientific diagrams. As artists, we will be investigating the life and work of Frida Kahlo. We will begin with self portraits and use watercolours to add colour to our artwork. In R.E. this week we will compare the different ways Christians celebrate the Last Supper. By the end of the lesson children will be able to explain the reasons for the differences between different churches in how they celebrate the last supper today.
