As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday. Please remember to practise your mock phonics screening check tests and watch Ruth Miskin videos

Maths No Problem:

As mathematicians, we will continue to explore division. We will be thinking about how to share numbers out equally. We will use our multiplication knowledge to help us make sure we have the same numbers in each group. We will also be applying our knowledge of division to solve word problems.

As scientists, we will continue to monitor the growth of our very own Dahlia seeds! We will also be learning about evergreen and deciduous trees as well as identifying the difference between evergreen and deciduous trees. Can you spot any evergreen trees in the area you live?
