At Star we pride ourselves on our uniform. Please make sure your child is wearing the correct uniform to school. Boots and jewellery are not part of the school uniform.

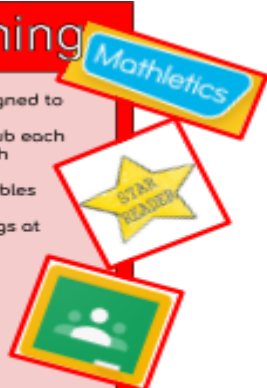
