This week's learning:

This week sees us attending another rehearsal for Festival of Voices, hosted by Ranelagh Primary School. As this is an afternoon visit we will not return to school until 3.00pm. A parentmail has been sent to parents and carers with the details.

Over 3 days this week, the children will be completing maths assessments as we have finished the first part of our Maths No Problem curriculum. On Wednesday, the children will complete a grammar and spelling test.

As scientists this week, we continue our work on electricity where the children will learn how to recognise common electrical conductors and insulators. They will name materials which are good electrical conductors and insulators, explain how this keeps us safe and choose appropriate materials to make different parts of switches. As geographers, we will plan and carry out a geographical investigation on rainfall in Kenya, plan the steps and strategies for our investigation and compare the amount of rainfall between Nairobi and London in. The children will be using secondary data in order to complete this task. As artist, we will complete our work inspired by Frida Kahlo, the children will experiment with creating mood, feeling and areas of interest by choosing the right materials and techniques learnt this term. They will then complete the task by explaining how they would improve their work using technical terms and give reasons for this.

We are asking all children continue practising their times tables, remember the practise tests are on Google Classroom. The teachers are seeing improvements every day!

The children will continue to participate in P.E. and music on Wednesday mornings and all children will be expected to attend school in their P.E. kit which they will wear for the whole day.
