This week's learning:

This week sees the start of our new topic called Global Treasures. We have lots of new learning to look forward to. In English, History and Shared Reading we will be exploring Julius Caesar and the Roman Empire. In our English lessons the children will learn how to write a play script and in history we will create a timeline of Roman presence in Britain and looking at maps of the Roman Empire.
