Our Learning

Our school theme this term:
Global Treasures



This half term we will be exploring Global Treasures, focusing on History and Design Technology.

English: As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

Please remember to practise your mock phonics screening check tests and watch Ruth Miskin videos everyday.

Maths: As mathematicians, we will be working with numbers up to 100. The children will be comparing numbers, thinking about which numbers are greater and which are less than.

Science: As scientists, we will continue to explore the topic of plants. The children have an exciting lesson ahead where they will go around our school investigating different types of plants. What plants can you see in your local area?

History: As historians, we will be looking at toys from different time periods and making comparisons.

Religious Education: As theologians, we will be thinking about what qualities a good leader has. We will be looking at the religion of Islam, and exploring the life of Mohammed; who he was and why he is special to Muslims.

R.S.H.E: As good citizens, we will be exploring the theme of Confidence.

Computing: In computing we will be using the internet to research a range of toy adverts and discuss the effectiveness of the adverts. The children will discuss what they like about the adverts as well as what they dislike.

Design Technology: As engineers, we will be exploring Levers and Sliders we come across in everyday life.
