Phonics/English:

We will be continuing our Read Write Inc phonics scheme where children will build their phonological knowledge and apply their writing skills to different genres of writing each week in our groups. Some groups will be continuing with the Writing Cycle where they will be focusing on writing letters based on the amazing play - *A Midsummer Night's Dream*.



Maths:

As mathematicians we will continue to explore fractions. We will also explore how we can find a fraction of a set. On Friday, we will move on to explore the topic of time and how to compare and sequence intervals of time.
