This week's learning:

We have an incredibly busy week ahead! The children are so looking forward to our workshops happening in school on Tuesday. We will be learning more about Julius Caesar and linking in our work on playscripts, we will be working with a theatre company to act out parts of this very famous play by William Shakespeare. We will continue with our Global Treasures topic this week and continue lots of new learning. In English, History and Shared Reading we will continue to read and learn about Julius Caesar and the Roman Empire. This week in our English lessons the children will be converting a story into their own play script and as historians we will learn more of the Roman presence in Britain and looking at maps of the Roman Empire. In our Maths No Problem lessons the children will be continue their second book and we will learning more about decimals. As scientists the children will continue their learning on electricity and in R.E. the children will begin to understand what vows are and the meaning behind vows or promises made in a wedding ceremony.
