

Our Learning

Our school theme this term: Global Treasures

This half term we will be exploring Global Treasures, focusing on History and Design Technology.

English: As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday. Please remember to practise your mock phonics screening check tests and watch Ruth Miskin videos

Maths: As mathematicians, we will be learning about money. The children will be working towards recognising coins and notes. Children will begin with looking at coins to help identify them through shape, markings, size and colour

Science: As scientists, we will continue to explore the topic of plants. The children will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants.

History: As historians, Children to compare modern and past toys. Are any of the toys the same/similar? Why do you think that is? Why are some of the toys so different then and now? How are they different? We will be thinking about what material they are made from,

how they are used, etc. E.g.dolls have always been around but look very different now

Religious Education: As theologians, we will . We will be looking at the religion of Islam, and exploring some artefacts.
