Our new topic is...Global Treasures!

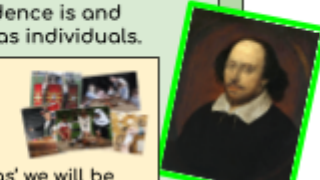
In RSHE, we will be learning all about what self confidence is and how we can continue to develop our self confidence as individuals.
