Our Learning

Our school theme this term: Global Treasures

This half term we will be exploring Global Treasures, focusing on History and Design Technology


English: As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

Please remember to practise your mock phonics screening check tests and watch Ruth Miskin videos everyday.

Maths: As mathematicians, we will be learning about money. The children will be working towards recognising coins and notes. Children will begin with looking at coins to help identify them through shape, markings, size and colour

Science: As scientists, we will continue to explore the topic of plants.

The children will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety



Religious Education: As theologians, we will be listing the ways in which a Muslim person demonstrates their faith. We will also be having a virtual mosque tour.

R.S.H.E: The children will complete a small challenge in groups and then reflect on how well they worked both independently and collaboratively. We'll be considering how much they pushed themselves throughout the task.
