This week's learning:

This week's learning will see the children complete the first week of the three-week cycle of their English lessons. They will be learning more about the Romans and completing their playscripts ready to type up on Google slides as part of their computing outcome. In maths, the children will complete the topic on money and prepare for the next topic on mass. As scientists, we will continue learning about electricity where the children will be making their own switches. In History, we used the Now PressPlay interactive resource to learn more about Roman Britain, the Roman army, Boudicca, the legacy of the Romans and the Iceni rebellion. All this new information will help us to understand why the Romans wanted to invade Britain. Our Spanish lessons continue to be enjoyed by everyone in Year 4, class teachers and TAs are learning the language alongside the children. Ask your child what Spanish they know, we have been learning how to spell our names using the Spanish alphabet.

A very busy week is ahead for the children and alongside these lessons they will be reading, learning spellings and times tables.

In our Laughology all about self confidence and support. This week we will be asking the children why they are awesome and how they can show this in their body language.

In P.E. the children will continue with athletics and will be developing their skills in the art of running consistently and smoothly at different speeds.

This will continue alongside music on a Wednesday morning where all children are expected in school in the correct P.E. kit.
