## This week's learning:

In maths this week, the children will be learning how to compare and round amounts of money, they will use their knowledge on decimals to help them. As writers, we are beginning writing cycle two and the children will start to plan a Roman fact file making sure they have researched the information they need and can set out a fact file using the correct features. As Scientists we are continuing our work on electricity where the children will create their own buzzer game. As Historians we will be suggesting reasons why the Romans faced rebellion from Boudicca and the Picts. As Engineers the children will use the knowledge learnt in previous lessons to make a moving chariot using levers and leverages. Ask your child what they know about loose and fixed pivots. In R.S.H.E. the children will reflect on how they have become more confident and independent lately. They will create a chant to feel more confident for our Festival of Voices performance. The children will be going to Ranelagh Primary School on Tuesday morning for a rehearsal, you would have received a reminder about this on Parent mail. Spanish lessons are going well with the children becoming so confident with their skills in pronunciation. Ask your child to teach you a few words!
