A huge snail - I was so brave!

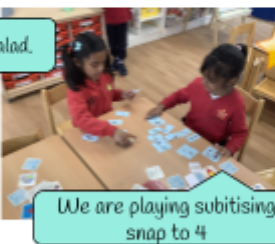


I am using the scissors!
