## This week's learning:

As mathematicians, the children will begin learning about mass, volume and length. They will be finding out how to convert between different units of measure for mass, measure length in centimetres, convert between metres and centimetres and metres and kilometres. The children are also learning to recall times tables facts quickly. Try this at home, how fast can your child answer a times table question? As writers we will be completing our work on the Romans and the children will be producing a polished fact file they have been researching and creating over the past few days. In History we will be looking at why the Romans left Britain and continuing to look at the legacy they left behind. In computing the children will be learning about online friendships and how to be kind online.
