## Our Learning

Our school theme this term:  
Healthy Hearts



**English:** As readers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday. Please remember to practise your mock phonics screening check tests and watch Ruth Miskin videos everyday.

**Maths:** As mathematicians, we will be exploring the concept of volume and capacity. This week, the children will be learning to compare volume using the terms 'more than' and 'less than', 'full', 'half full' and 'empty.'

**Geography:** As geographers, we will be drawing a map of our favourite places in our local area.

**Science:** As Scientists, we will exploring the 5 senses. This week, children will be going on a walk around the school and will record all the sounds they hear.

**RE:** As theologians, we will be learning about Hinduism. This week, we will be thinking about the people who help us.
