
Finally, a massive well done to our local football team WEST HAM for winning the Europa Conference League. I'm sure many fans will be celebrating this weekend.

Last Tuesday our aspiring Star cricketers took part in a tournament at West Ham Memorial Ground. With some very close and competitive matches it was a great introduction



Did you come to school everyday this week? Which classes achieved the highest




