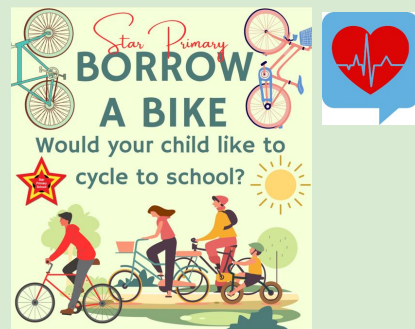


## Pupil Leader's Weekly Reflection
