# Our Learning

# Our school theme this term: Healthu Hearts



This half term we will be exploring Global Treasures, focusing on History and Design Technology. English: Next week, starting on Monday the 12th of June we will be starting our Phonic Screening Check. Please ensure you continue to practise any sounds with your child that they may need support

Maths: As mathematicians, we will continue to explore the concept of volume and capacity. We will be comparing amounts and solving practical problems.

Science: As Scientists, we will exploring the 5 senses. This week, children will be exploring the sense of touch. The children will be using feely bags to touch and describe various objects using scientific

Geography: As geographers, we will using simple maps of the local area. We will also be using aerial photographs of the school to help us identify differents parts of the school.

Religious Education: As theologians, we will be learning about Hinduism. This week we will be exploring the concept of Karma. We will focus on the 5 main duties of a Hindu and link the idea of Karma to consequences.
