This week's learning:

FESTIVAL of VOICES - The time has finally arrived!!! On Tuesday 13th June the children will make their way to the Hackney Empire in preparation to wow you all with their fantastic singing. You should have received a Parent Mail with all the information. Do try your best to come along and support your child they have worked so incredibly hard.

This week the children will continue working on our topic of Healthy Hearts. This will run alongside our Multiplication Tables Check this week. We will begin testing on Thursday this week and continue into next week too. The MTC is an online test where the pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables 2 to 12. For every question you have 6 seconds to answer and in between the questions there is a 3-second rest. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC. The children have had lots of practise and are ready to complete this check.

As writers, the children will begin creating explanation texts by composing and rehearsing sentences orally and creating draft copies of their work. As mathematicians, the children will be looking at area and perimeter. As scientists, we will continue learning about animals including humans and this week we will learn and explain why different animal feeding types have different teeth. As theologians, children will thoughtfully outline similarities and differences between different places of worship in our neighbourhood. As geographers, we will be looking at the different regions in the United Kingdom.

P.E. and Fit Friday will continue to play a big part in our Healthy Hearts topic this term. We're set for some very warm weather this week so please apply sunscreen to children in the morning.
