This week's learning...



English: As part of our transition to secondary school, we will be focusing on all the changes and challenges that we will face when moving to secondary school. This will include developing new routines, developing new friendships, managing our emotions and maintaining good self-esteem. We will be taking part in a review of our learning over the past year and reflecting on our achievements.

Science: We will be investigating how animals and plants adapt in extreme conditions and how living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary. Then we will move onto exploring how water and nutrients are transported around our body through our blood. We will take part in a range of activities to better understand the circulatory system.
