Our Learning

Our school theme this term: Healthy Hearts



This half term we will be exploring Global Treasures, focusing on History and Design Technology.

English: We will be continuing to read and explore stories from RWI. Well done for all your hard work last week on the Phonics Screener!

Maths: As Mathematicians, we will begin to explore the concept of Mass. We will be using the vocabulary of lighter and heavier.

Science: As Scientists, we will exploring the 5 senses. This week, children will be continuing our exploration of Touch inspired by the traditional tale, The Princess and the Pea.
