English: In our Writing Cycle we will continue to focus on the story, "What's going on inside my head?", which our lessons will be based on.



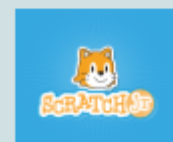
Maths: In Maths we will be continuing our learning on 'time' and begin to look at measuring and comparing volume in litres!
