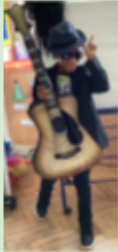
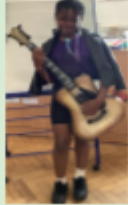
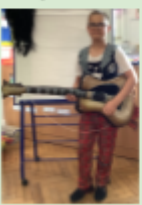

This week's learning:

This week the children will continue working on our topic of Healthy Hearts.

On Tuesday, we will be visited by teachers and students for the ELUTEC Academy. In each year 4 class we will have some year 12 students delivering workshops to our children all about the digestive system. We will look at the impact of sugar on teeth, the digestive system and items excreted indicating healthy and unhealthy diets. The children will participate in some fun experiments!

As writers the children will begin to write instruction texts around seasonal food and creating a healthy menu. This will link very nicely with our Design and Technology lesson where the children will be making a seasonal calendar and learning why using seasonal food is important. We will look at what ingredients we will add taking in allergies and food intolerances. They will also be harvesting some seasonal foods from Star garden and using these ingredients to create a salad for us to enjoy. Along with their salad they will be making a salad dressing from scratch too!

We will also begin two maths assessments this week along with a grammar tests, these will help inform our end of year reports.
