Please make sure that you come to school in smart school uniform and neat hair. Pupil leaders need to proudly wear their badges!

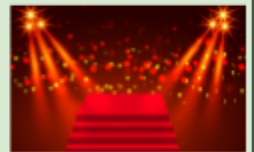
#### Secondary School Transition Day - Thursday 6th July
