


Woodblock printing workshop Wednesday 16 August 2-4pm Uncover the possibilities of this ancient process



The Line is a public art project in East London that connects Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park and The O2, following the waterways and the line of the Greenwich Meridian. Its outdoor exhibition programme offers a journey through a dynamic urban landscape where everyone can explore art, nature and heritage for free.

Here to There is a wayfinding commission on The Line between Star Lane Station and Cody Dock. Artist Katie Schwab's artwork will draw on the rich history of textile block-printing and synthetic dye production in the Lower Lea. It will be co-produced with local residents and will enhance the route to the River Lea at Cody Dock. The installation is being developed by The Line with support from the London Borough of Newham's 'Connecting to Opportunities' programme.
