Our school theme this term: Healthy Hearts



This half term we will be exploring Global Treasures, focusing on History and Design Technology.

Geography: As Geographers, we will using simple maps of the local area. We will also use locational and directional language to describe the location of features and


Religious Education: As Theologians, we will be learning about Hinduism. This week we will be identifying why Krishna is important to Hindu people.
