Our Learning

Our school theme this term:
Healthy Hearts



This half term we will be exploring Global Treasures, focusing on History and Design Technology.

English: We will be continuing to read and explore stories from RWI. Well done for all your hard work last week on the Phonics Screener!

Maths: This week is Outdoor Maths Week - we will be taking our learning outside and applying what we've learnt this year! We can't wait for our shape hunt on the school field!

Science: As Scientists, we will be exploring the 5 senses. This week, children will be exploring our sense of smell. The children will carry out a smell test by passing around a few different smelly samples. Children discuss whether or not they like or dislike the smells.

Geography: As Geographers, we will be using simple maps of the local area. We will also use locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes.

Religious Education: As Theologians, we will be learning about Hinduism. This week we will be identifying why Krishna is important to Hindu people.

Design Technology: As Engineers, we will be exploring what good picnic food is. We will also prepare and taste some healthy picnic foods and evaluate if they are balanced or not.

Don't forget...

- **Read everyday for 10 minutes.** We will be giving out three reading books; an Oxford book, a decodable RWI book and a read for pleasure book. We highly encourage all children to read at home everyday with a comment written in their reading diaries.
- All children must come to school wearing Fit Friday t-shirts and trainers each Friday.
- **Bug Club and Mathletics** please ensure your child accesses these apps for 5 or 10 minutes each day. On a Friday, each class will announce their Bug Club and Mathletics champions.
