This half term's theme is Healthy Hearts!!

In English we will be focusing on instructional writing. This week we will be creating a toolkit for instructional writing. This will help us to write our set of instructions in three weeks time.

In Maths we will be starting a new Topic- Fractions. This week our focus will be finding fractions of shapes by counting in tenths.
