#### This week's learning.

We have another very busy week of learning ahead! We will continue with our Rights theme this half term which is Freedom and Safety.

In Shared Reading we will continue to read Azzi In Between. The children will be exploring the characters in the book and answering questions about what they have read. As Writers, we continue to explore narrative and the children will begin to plan their own stories.

As Mathematicians, the children will be learning how to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000 and look for patterns in numbers. In computing, we will be learning how a strong password can can help protect our privacy. This lesson will help children to create a password that is secure and memorable.

As Scientists, the children will measure the temperature at which solids melt. We will introduce the concept of melting point and investigate the melting point of different materials - chocolate, butter, metal and cheese using a water bath.

As Historians we will be learning about the Civil Rights Movement, how it developed and the impact it had on history.

We are noticing some very aspiring artists in year 4 and this week we will continue learning about the artist Pablo Picasso. The children will be creating their own portraits inspired by his work.

In R.E. we will be learning about who and what influenced Pandurang. We will make connections between religious teachings and the lives of followers.

P.E. this term sees the children working on their gymnastics skills and how to play competitive games.

Finally, in music, the children will continue with their Rockin' Recorders work.

Ask your child to show you the dance their are learning as part of our Fit Friday sessions this term.
