This term our school theme is HUMAN RIGHTS.

#### Enalish:

As writers, we will be continving our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds, reading and writing everyday.



Maths:

As mathematicians, we will be exploring subtraction within 10.

Science: As scientists, we will be identify materials some objects are made of. Children will be drawing a diagram in their books and labelling the materials.
