We have another very busy week of learning ahead!

We are continuing our theme on freedom and safety this week. In

Shared Reading we will continue to read Azzi In Between. The children
will be reading for purpose and using their comprehension skills to
answer questions about the text. As writers this week, we will end cycle
1 with a week of writing our own stories using paragraphs, exciting
vocabulary and correct punctuation. The children will learn how to
proofread their work and edit to create a published piece on Friday.
As scientists we will observe that some materials change state when
they are heated or cooled? (evaporation and condensation). As
Historians we will begin to offer our opinion on the views of MLK and
Malcolm X. As part of our Black History Month celebration, as artists we
will study Sonia Boyce who often included herself in her artworks and
many of her drawings addressing the subjects of race, identity and
growing up in London.

In R.E. this week, the children will explain how religious beliefs can be shown through special objects. We will be comparing and contrasting different objects and religions.

In our computing lessons, we will use search technologies effectively, appreciate how results are selected and ranked and be discerning in evaluating digital content.
