Our Learning





This term our school theme is Media Mayhem.

English:

As writers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds, reading and writing everyday.

1aths:

As mathematicians, we will be learning about numbers up to 20. Please remember to keep accessing Mathletics at home where work linked to this topic will be assigned.

R.E.:

This week we are having an exciting visitor to the school. They will be talking to the children about why Christians give gifts at Christmas and we will be thinking about the Christmas story.

Science:
