In our English lessons this week we are beginning our newspaper work. We have been reading the story Oliver Twist by Charles Dickens and the children will be reporting on a part of the story to create their own newspaper articles.

We are continuing our Maths - No Problem! scheme where we are working on multiplication skills. The children will work in their workbooks and demonstrate their understanding of their learning in their maths journals. This week in RE we will learn why the Bible is important to Christians and describe how beliefs / stories from the Bible impact people's lives. As Historians, the children will create timelines to show when in history the Industrial Revolution occurred.
