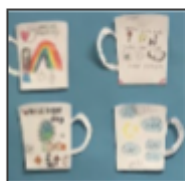

I made a rangoli pattern using pink powder.

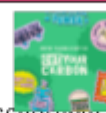


I am using different colours of rice to make my rangoli pattern.
